

Study association Digi Juridica contribution and payment conditions

Regarding the payment of contributions from members of the study association Digi Juridica, filed with the Chamber of Commerce in Amsterdam under no. 64668282.

Article 1 General / definitions

- a) The *association*: the Digi Juridica study association with legal personality, established in Amsterdam.
- b) *Members*: natural or legal persons who have entered a membership in accordance with the articles of association of the association.
- c) *Association year*: the association year is the same as the financial year in accordance with the rules of procedure, namely from 1 September up to and including 31 August.

Article 2 Contribution

1. Registration as a member of Study Association Digi Juridica in the register is done in accordance with the statutes and the rules of procedure and takes place against a one-off contribution such as the one paid by the general meeting before or at the latest at the time of the budget for members is established.
2. The members owe the contribution on the first day of the association year or on the day of registration as a member.
3. Register as a member is possible at any time. The membership covers a period of two years and amounts to € 10. At the end of this period, a member automatically becomes alumni.

Article 3 Adjustment of the contribution

1. The general meeting of members of the association is authorized to adjust the amount of the contribution annually.
2. If the financial situation of the association gives cause for this, the general meeting of members is entitled to adjust the contribution.

Article 4 Cancellation

1. The membership of the association does not end automatically for two years.
2. Nevertheless, immediate termination of the membership through cancellation is possible within one month after a contribution increase under Article 3.2 has been notified.
3. The association may cancel the membership by return if the member fails to return despite repeated reminder. The member remains obliged to pay the contribution due or other obligations arising from membership.

4. A member who has canceled must continue to comply with the financial obligations arising from his membership or participation.

Article 5 Defaults

1. In the event of non-payment, the association is entitled to suspend the delivery of products and services by virtue of membership, registration or agreement with the association. After full payment of the contribution due, the member will from that moment be placed on the mailing list again and he will be eligible for the member services again.

Article 6 Complaints

1. Complaints about services provided or products supplied by or on behalf of the association must be submitted in writing to the secretary of the association.
2. Complaints submitted do not suspend the payment obligation.
3. Any disputes will be submitted to the competent court.

Article 7 Applicable law

1. Dutch law applies to membership in the association.
2. These regulations must be adopted by the general meeting of members before or at the latest at the time of the discussion of the budget for members.
